"If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well."

**Mark 5:25-34** *(along with Matthew 9:20-22; Luke 8:43-48)*

25 Now a certain woman had a flow of  
blood for twelve years,

26 and had suffered many things from many  
physicians. She had spent all that she had  
and was no better, but rather grew worse.

**Mark 5:25-34** (continued)

27 When she heard about Jesus, she came behind *Him* in the crowd and touched His garment.

28 For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well."

29 Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in *her* body that she was healed of the affliction.

**Mark 5:25-34** (continued)

30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, "Who touched My clothes?"

31 But His disciples said to Him, "You see the multitude thronging You, and You say, 'Who touched Me?' "

32 And He looked around to see her who had done this thing.

**Mark 5:25-34** (continued)

33 But the woman, fearing and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth.

34 And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction."

**Note:** After twelve years of suffering this woman finds healing and freedom from in Jesus. What makes this healing so notable and powerful is that until the woman was healed Jesus didn't even know about her or her condition. Jesus didn't speak the healing, nor did He lay His hands on her. Instead, this woman simply touched His garment and she was made whole. Her healing came to her simply by touching the clothes that Jesus was wearing.

**v.30)**

**Power** (Grk. 1411) *dunamis*

1) strength power, ability

1a) inherent power, power residing in a thing by virtue of its nature, or which a person or thing exerts and puts forth

1b) *power for performing miracles*

1c) moral power and excellence of soul

1d) the power and influence which belong to riches and wealth

1e) power and resources arising from numbers

1f) power consisting in or resting upon armies, forces, hosts

It was her faith that pulled on the “power” that was in Jesus. All she needed to do was put her faith into action by touching the garment of Jesus and by doing so she drew the power to heal directly from Jesus.

## Many Touched His Garment

### Matthew 14:35-36

35 And when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent out into all that surrounding region, brought to Him all who were sick,

36 and begged Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched *it* were made perfectly well.

**Note:** Most times we are taught from the passage above (the woman with the flow of blood), and we can completely miss that this story can be multiplied many times over. There were many people that gained their healing simply by touching the clothes that Jesus wore.

The “power” that was in Jesus could be drawn out of Him for healing by faith and a touch. The people who received their healing by merely touching Jesus’ garment did so by faith. They knew that His power was such that all they needed to do was to touch what He was wearing.

*Mark's Account*

**Mark 6:54-56**

54 And when they came out of the boat, immediately the people recognized Him,

55 ran through that whole surrounding region, and began to carry about on beds those who were sick to wherever they heard He was.

56 Wherever He entered, into villages, cities, or the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might just touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched Him were made well.

## The WHOLE Multitude Sought to Touch Him

### Luke 6:17-19

17 And He came down with them and stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases,

18 as well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were healed.

19 And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed *them* all.

**Note:** Once again we see that everyone that was sick sought to touch Jesus. Every person that touched Jesus was healed. This once again shows the power of Jesus to heal the sick, and His great desire for everyone to be healed. His love and compassion for people caused Him to remain in a place as multitudes pressed in on Him to touch Him.

## Faith that can be Seen

### Acts 14:9-10

9 This man heard Paul speaking. Paul, observing him intently and seeing that he had faith to be healed

10 said with a loud voice, "Stand up straight on your feet!" And he leaped and walked.

**Note:** The man in this story had a faith could be seen. There was something that drew the attention of Paul to this man. There may have been something that Paul could see in the natural; however, there was something deeper than something as the look on his face. There was something that drew upon Paul; it was this man's faith. His faith was the determining factor in this story and what drew the attention and anointing of Paul to him.

**Where is YOUR Faith?**

**Matthew 9:29**

Then He touched their eyes, saying,  
"According to your faith let it be to you."

**Mark 10:52**

Then Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your  
faith has made you well." And immediately he  
received his sight and followed Jesus on the  
road.

### Where is YOUR Faith?

#### **Luke 7:50**

Then He said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you. Go in peace."

#### **Luke 17:19**

And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."

#### **Luke 18:42**

Then Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; your faith has made you well."

**Note:** In each of these verses Jesus says essentially the same thing, "Your faith has made you well." This is an astounding statement from the Healer Himself, because He could have said, "My power has made you well." Jesus had every right to say something as this, but He showed how the person's faith had to agree with His power in order to be healed.

## Hebrews 11:6

But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

**Conclusion:** Whether it be a “Command” by the Lord Himself, a “Touch” by His hands, or if we come and “Touch” Him, no matter what the means of healing, if we want His power to touch us we must have faith that He can and will heal us.
