

Psalm 139:23-24

23 Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties;

24 And see if *there is any* wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.

David is asking God to:

- *Examine him*
- *Prove him*
- *Try (test) his mind and heart*
- *Search him (inwardly)*
- *Know his heart*
- *Try (test) him*
- *Know his anxieties*
- *See if there is any wicked way in him*

Why?

- To “lead me in the way everlasting”

Right now, everything is being tested

- *We are being Tested as individuals*
- *We are being Tested as a Church*
- *We are being Tested as a City and State*
- *We are being Tested as a Nation*

Isaiah 48:10

Behold, I have refined you, but not as silver; I have tested you in the furnace of affliction.

Our Wilderness Travels

Deuteronomy 8:1-2

1 "Every commandment which I command you today you must be careful to observe, that you may live and multiply, and go in and possess the land of which the LORD swore to your fathers.

2 And you shall remember that the LORD your God led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you *and* test you, to know what *was* in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

In this passage we find another reason why God led them in the wilderness for 40 years.

God used this time to:

- *Humble them*
- *Test them*
- *Know what was in their heart*
- *Know whether they would keep His commands or not*

Remember

It was prophesied that this Virus would be settled by Passover.

Esther Had a Choice

Esther 4:13-14

13 And Mordecai told *them* to answer Esther: "Do not think in your heart that you will escape in the king's palace any more than all the other Jews.

14 For if you remain completely silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father's house will perish. Yet who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for *such* a time as this?"

Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, "Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it."
