# **Developing Relationships- Winning Souls**

## **Acts 8:26-40**

26 Now an angel of the Lord spoke to Philip, saying, "Arise and go toward the south along the road which goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." This is desert.

**Acts 8:26-40** (continued)

27 So he arose and went. And behold, a man of Ethiopia, a eunuch of great authority under Candace the queen of the Ethiopians, who had charge of all her treasury, and had come to Jerusalem to worship,

28 was returning. And sitting in his chariot, he was reading Isaiah the prophet.

**Acts 8:26-40** (continued)

29 Then the Spirit said to Philip, "Go near and overtake this chariot."

30 So Philip ran to him, and heard him reading the prophet Isaiah, and said, "Do you understand what you are reading?"

31 And he said, "How can I, unless someone guides me?" And he asked Philip to come up and sit with him.

**Acts 8:26-40** (continued)

32 The place in the Scripture which he read was this: "HE WAS LED AS A SHEEP TO THE SLAUGHTER; AND AS A LAMB BEFORE ITS SHEARER IS SILENT, SO HE OPENED NOT HIS MOUTH.

33 IN HIS HUMILIATION HIS JUSTICE WAS TAKEN AWAY, AND WHO WILL DECLARE HIS GENERATION? FOR HIS LIFE IS TAKEN FROM THE EARTH."

**Acts 8:26-40** (continued)

34 So the eunuch answered Philip and said, "I ask you, of whom does the prophet say this, of himself or of some other man?"

35 Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning at this Scripture, preached Jesus to him.

**Acts 8:26-40** (continued)

36 Now as they went down the road, they came to some water. And the eunuch said, "See, *here is* water. What hinders me from being baptized?"

37 Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."

**Acts 8:26-40** (continued)

38 So he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and he baptized him.

39 Now when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught Philip away, so that the eunuch saw him no more; and he went on his way rejoicing.

**Acts 8:26-40** (continued)

40 But Philip was found at Azotus. And passing through, he preached in all the cities till he came to Caesarea.

- Leading by the Spirit of the Lord
- Willingness of Philip
- Obedience of Philip
- Open heart of the Eunuch
- An Open Bible (Scroll)
- Salvation with Baptism

## Acts 16:13-15

13 And on the Sabbath day we went out of the city to the riverside, where prayer was customarily made; and we sat down and spoke to the women who met *there*.

14 Now a certain woman named Lydia heard *us*. She was a seller of purple from the city of Thyatira, who worshiped God. The Lord opened her heart to heed the things spoken by Paul.

## **Acts 16:13-15 (continued)**

15 And when she and her household were baptized, she begged *us*, saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come to my house and stay." So she persuaded us.

## **Matthew 28:18-20**

<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, “All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

<sup>19</sup> **Go** therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen.

# Joseph the Servant - Joseph the Leader

## Genesis 39:20-23

<sup>20</sup> Then Joseph's master took him and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners were confined. And he was there in the prison.

## **Genesis 39:20-23** (continued)

**21** But the Lord was with Joseph and showed him mercy, and He gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison.

**22** And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners who were in the prison; whatever they did there, it was his doing.

## **Genesis 39:20-23** (continued)

<sup>23</sup> The keeper of the prison did not look into anything that was under Joseph's authority, because the Lord was with him; and whatever he did, the Lord made it prosper.

## **Genesis 40:1-4**

<sup>1</sup> It came to pass after these things that the butler and the baker of the king of Egypt offended their lord, the king of Egypt.

<sup>2</sup> And Pharaoh was angry with his two officers, the chief butler and the chief baker.

## **Genesis 40:1-4 (continued)**

**<sup>3</sup> So he put them in custody in the house of the captain of the guard, in the prison, the place where Joseph was confined.**

**<sup>4</sup> And the captain of the guard charged Joseph with them, and he served them; so they were in custody for a while.**

## **Genesis 41:9-14**

**<sup>9</sup> Then the chief butler spoke to Pharaoh, saying:**

**“I remember my faults this day.**

**<sup>10</sup> When Pharaoh was angry with his servants, and put me in custody in the house of the captain of the guard, both me and the chief baker,**

**<sup>11</sup> we each had a dream in one night, he and I. Each of us dreamed according to the interpretation of his own dream.**

## **Genesis 41:9-14** (continued)

<sup>12</sup> Now there was a young Hebrew man with us there, a servant of the captain of the guard. And we told him, and he interpreted our dreams for us; to each man he interpreted according to his own dream.

## **Genesis 41:9-14** (continued)

<sup>13</sup> And it came to pass, just as he interpreted for us, so it happened. He restored me to my office, and he hanged him.”

<sup>14</sup> Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him quickly out of the dungeon; and he shaved, changed his clothing, and came to Pharaoh.
